DID YOU KNOW??

- South Mountain Park/Preserve in Phoenix is the largest municipal park in the country.
- Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station, located about 50 miles west of Phoenix, generates more electricity than any other U.S. power plant.
- Cochiti, a Hopi village located in Navajo County, Arizona, dates back to before A.D. 1300 and is reported to be the oldest continuously inhabited community in America.
- Built by Del Webb in 1960, Sun City, Arizona was the first 55+ year active adult retirement community in the country.
- The Saguaro cactus is the largest cactus found in the U.S. It can grow as high as a five-story building and is native to the Sonoran Desert.
- Spanish Franciscan friar Marcos de Niza was the first European to explore Arizona. He entered the area in 1539.
- The best preserved meteor crater in the world is located near Winslow, Arizona.
- The Arizona Cardinals are the oldest continuous franchise in the National Football League, dating back to 1899.
- Arizona became the 48th state and last of our contiguous states on February 14, 1912.
- Arizona's disparate climate can yield both the highest temperatures across the nation and the lowest temperature across the nation in the same day.
- Arizona has the largest contiguous stand of ponderosa pines in the world.
- The "Five Cs" of Arizona's economy are: Cattle, Copper, Citrus, Cotton, and Climate.
- More copper is mined in Arizona than all the other states combined, and the Mount Miss is the largest copper producer in all of North America.
- The world's largest solar telescope is located at Kitt Peak National Observatory in Pima, Arizona.
- The Sonoran Desert is the most biologically diverse desert in North America.
- The two largest man-made lakes in the U.S. are Lake Mead and Lake Powell - both located in Arizona.
- Thirteen species of rattlesnakes live in Arizona, more species than in any other state.
